MAKING MEMBERSHIP MATTER

How Green Grass Notes Transformed Community Through Technology



Green Grass Notes is a non-profit support group for families with children with special educational needs (SEN) and disabilities, as well as adults with SEN and disabilities. Run by dedicated volunteers, the community-driven organization offers music courses and social events for its members. The music courses serve to unite children with differing levels of disability and provide them with a sense of belonging. The social events provide a platform for members to meet and socialize with others facing similar challenges.

Event Management Issues Come to Light

Non-profit organizations like Green Grass Notes often face challenges such as fundraising, limited resources, and event management. One specific issue for Green Grass Notes is the registration process for events, which has led to errors, nonmembers signing up, and increased workload for volunteers. A hypothetical fundraising event serves as an example of such issues. The organization sends invitations to its members, stating that the event is solely for them. However, a member forwards the invitation to a nonmember friend, who then registers for the event and wins a place. The organization must then decide whether to allow the nonmember to attend or revoke the invitation, causing confusion and frustration among members and nonmembers alike, ultimately damaging the organization's reputation. "Members would sometimes forward event invitations to friends," Helen, chairman of Green Grass Notes recalled. "As a result, nonmembers could register for events and won places. We appeared disorganized."

A Solution Emerges: The 社·團 Community Platform

Green Grass Notes found a solution to their event management challenges by using 社·團, a straight-forward community platform for creating their own membership mini app. With the help of William, a member and a sales rep for 社·團, Helen was able to create a modern community experience without needing to hire IT staff. William provided invaluable assistance in setting up the app and helping the

organization get up and running.

Benefits of using 社·團 for event management at Green Grass Notes are significant. For starters, the platform streamlined the registration process, eliminating typing errors and preventing nonmembers from registering. This saved several man-hours a month previously spent on processing registrations.

Immediate Benefits: Streamlined Processes and Stronger Connections

The platform also increased active participation in discussion forums, with 60% of members now engaging, a significant increase attributable to the user-friendly interface of 社·團. Moreover, the platform reduced the number of unwanted instant messages received by members by 5 per day, allowing members to focus on relevant and meaningful conversations. During the provision of technical assistance, volunteers identified and offered emotional support to members in need, showcasing the platform's potential to facilitate a supportive, engaged community.
